**GENERAL:**

In accordance with Township Ordinance No. 46, any work performed within the Township's right-of-way shall require an Occupancy Permit, issued by Northampton Township. Applicant shall submit this application form (4 copies), including the Highway Occupancy Permit Sketch (Page 2), showing location and details of the proposed work. The prescribed Permit Fee shall accompany each permit application. Checks or Money Orders shall be made payable to Northampton Township.

Any permit issued will be under, and subject to, the conditions, restrictions and regulations of PennDOT Publication 408 (where applicable), all applicable Township Ordinance and specifications included with each application.

All work shall be subject to inspection by the Township Engineer (CKS Engineers, Inc. 215-340-0600). Minimum notice of 48 hours shall be provided. Failure to comply may result in forfeit of permit fees.

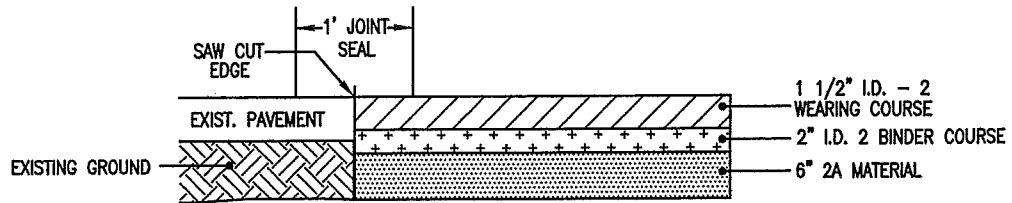

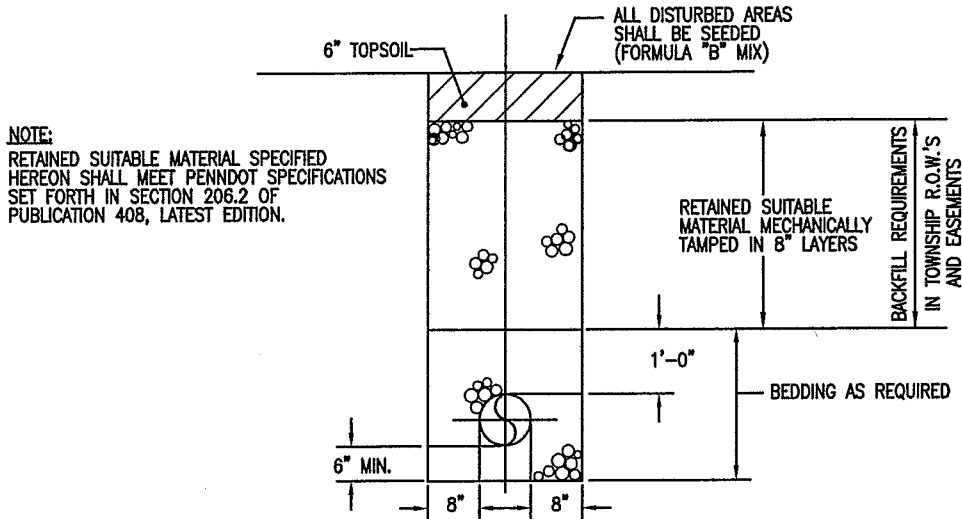

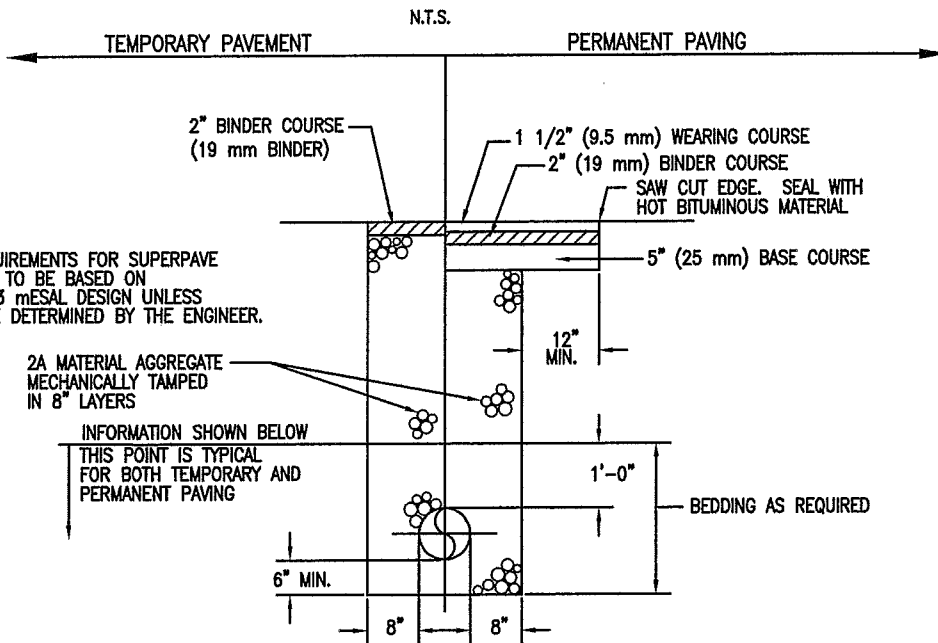
**TYPICAL DRIVEWAY PAVING DETAIL**

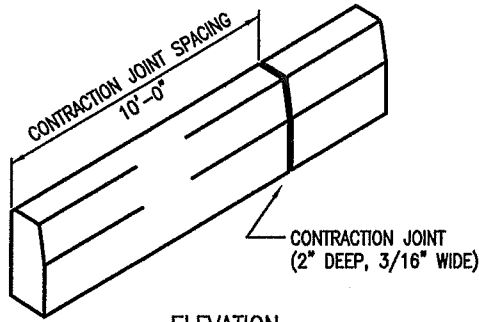

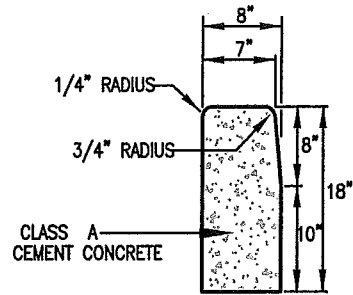

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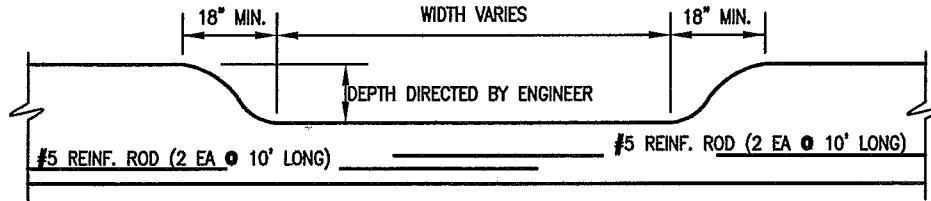
ELEVATION

**PLAIN CEMENT CONCRETE CURB**

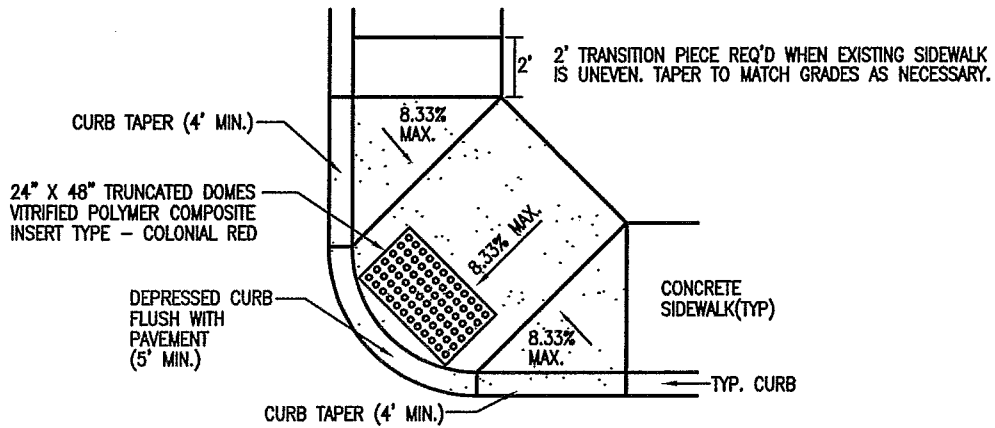

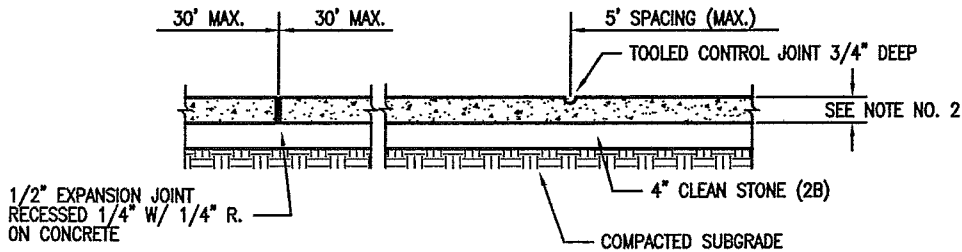
