ORDINANCE NO. _____**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF NORTHAMPTON TOWNSHIP, CHAPTER 108 (SEWERS), PART 2 (SEWAGE HOLDING TANKS), ARTICLE VI, TO AMEND SECTION 108-32 TO ADD SUBSECTION D.

The Board of Supervisors of Northampton Township does hereby **ENACT** and **ORDAIN** as follows:

SECTION I. – Amendment to Code

The Codified Ordinances of Northampton Township, Chapter 108 (Sewers), Part 2 (Sewage Holding Tanks), Article VI, is hereby amended to modify Section 108-32 to add subsection D.

108-32. Areas in which holding tanks permitted.

- D. Permanent on-lot holding tanks are permitted to serve institutions or commercial establishments with a sewage flow of less than 800 gallons per day. In the event that public sewer is ever available, the property must connect and meet all applicable requirements of the Northampton Bucks County Municipal Authority.

SECTION II. – Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts, or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION III. – Failure to Enforce not a Waiver

The Failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION IV. – Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.

SECTION V. – Repealer

All other ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
