The Spread Eagle Inn in the heart of Richboro is among the township's earliest buildings. A traveler wrote in 1858 that weary travelers were fortunate, when reaching Richboro after a long day on the road, to have two taverns from which to chopse: the White Bear Hotel, now known as the Spread Eagle Inn, or the Black Bear Hotel, no longer in existence. Documentation shows that the White Bear was built by Enoch Addis, who purchased the property where the building still stands in July 1790 from Peter and Sarah Stryker. References to an inn being in existence on the White Bear site appear as early as 1793, when a sign advertised lodgings "for men and beasts." It is likely that this was a smaller building on the property, perhaps Enoch's residence, since he bought the property in 1790. In May of 1810, Addis officially petitioned the county court to open a tayern at the site.




