To all municipal authorities and drillers,

On January 1st. 2011, the newly revised Bucks County Department of Health Rules and Regulations Governing All Wells and Their Construction Specifications take effect. Enclosed is a copy of the revised regulations. As the new title implies, all types of wells will now be regulated and permitted by this Department. (For reference, the previous title was Rules and Regulations Governing Individual Residential Water Supply Systems and Construction Specifications.)

Only wells specifically covered by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection regulations are excluded. In general, excluded wells are wells with a minimum of 15 service connections and 25 year round residents.

Below is the list of wells that will now be required to be permitted and inspected by this Department:

- 1. Individual Residential wells.
- 2. Geo-Thermal Wells
- 3. Agricultural Wells
- 4. Monitoring Wells
- 5. Commercial and Community Residential Wells that do not meet the PADEP criteria listed above.

All geo-thermal wells, whether closed loop or open loop, will now be fully regulated. They may only be installed by contractors who are licensed well drillers in Pennsylvania or who have passed an International Ground Source Heat Pump Association (IGSHPA) approved training course.
