#### **Approval of April 2024 Minutes**

The Board approved the May 2024 Meeting Minutes unanimously.

### **Library Director Report**

- The next Friends of FLNT meeting is Wednesday, June 19 @ 7 PM in the Library's Board Room. Lahr will not be in attendance. Michael May will represent the Board at the meeting.
- Summer Quest 2024 begins Saturday, June 15 with a big Kick-Off Celebration from 10 AM to Noon. The event will include Scott the Balloon Man, face painting, outside yard games and activities, free books, crafts, a scavenger hunt in the library, new Summer Reading logs, and Rita's Water Ice. Our summer reading prizes feature new homemade themed buttons/pins for kids!
- Local companies contributing items to kids' book clubs: Acme (Book Bunch Jr., water and bagged snacks), Philly Pretzel Factory (Book Bunch, mini pretzels at a 50% discount), Rita's of Richboro (water ice at 50% discount), and Gianni's will be contributing pizzas to 2 teen book club meetings.
- Lahr participated in the most recent Northampton Township Business & Professional Association meeting at the NVCC for breakfast.

# **Strategic Plan Status**

- Priority #1 Build a Culture of Learning
  - Met on 5/30. Focus of the meeting was to review Priority 1 and its Objectives and Action steps to discuss where we are and where we need to be with specific steps for

- the future. Follow-up on Library of Things in July. Adding Family Read Aloud program for 2 sessions this summer and will evaluate to determine whether to continue.
- Discussed possibly aligning with SCORE to offer programs at library (retired executives who assist individuals with business-related services such as job search, writing business plans, etc.)
- Next meeting not yet scheduled; probably to discuss Library of Things project
- Priority #2 Community Partnerships
  - Lahr attended the Northampton Business & Professional Association breakfast networking event on June 5. He plans to determine an approach for this committee beginning in July.
- Priority #3 Effective Communication
  - Last meeting was held on 6/7
  - Creative Brief/RFP draft has been finalized. The plan is to distribute it to six vendors that have been identified and have indicated an interest in partnering with us.
  - Our target is to have new logo, branding by end of year
  - o Next meeting not yet scheduled; branding vendor meetings probably the next step
- Priority #4a Contemporary Facilities (Interior)
  - Last meeting was held on 5/6
  - No new committee meetings since last Board meeting, however, we have had Teams calls with 4 architectural firms:
    - 1. Kimmel Bogrette
    - 2. Michael Graves
    - 3. OBN Architects
    - 4. JR Keller LLC
  - Lahr scheduling meeting in July (25<sup>th</sup>) for board members and Bill Wert to review our next steps. At this point, staff has provided a great deal of input and will be included again in the future. Lahr and Wert need to update the Twp. Manager, Pellegrino, on our progress.
  - Next meeting not yet scheduled; probably additional architect conversations
- Priority #4b Contemporary Facilities (Exterior)
  - o Same update as Priority #4b, architects seeing both as integrated project
